## Criteria

- Achieve either 3 'A's at A Level, or 3 'A' grade Advanced Highers or 5 'A' grade Highers or International Baccalaureate Diploma at 36 points or above or HND Diploma with distinction
- Be on an IET accredited BEng/MEng programme starting in Autumn 2015\*
- Be a UK resident
- Not be in receipt of another IET scholarship or grant.

Students who meet the minimum criteria will be eligible to apply for one of up to 70 Diamond Jubilee scholarships. Each scholarship is worth at least £1,000 per year for the duration of the degree course, meaning at least £3,000 for Bachelors students and at least £4,000 for MEng students. The scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis.

- Applications must be submitted by **30 June 2015** (online submission)
- Supporting documentation by **27 August 2015** (A level, Advanced Highers or Highers, International Baccalaureate Diploma at 36 points or above or HND with distinction results transcripts & UCAS confirmation)
- Decision **December 2015**
- First payments **January 2016**.
